## THE ALPHABET CHART

The first stage of comprehension and Phonics is taught with the Alphabet Chart. The presentation of letters and sounds is ordered according to difficulty. The inclusion of a vowel in each track anticipates the commencement of blending three letter words.

## WHAT TO DO:

*THE ALPHABET CHART ACCOMPANIES THE ALPHABET AND PHONICS CD.*

- Place the child at a desk with the alphabet chart in front
- Turn on the CD
- Initiate the child to the program by following the letters and sounds in the order presented on the CD
- Limit exposure to one letter and sound per session
- Remediate by navigating to the unknown letters and sounds on the tracking sheet
- Repeat regularly to consolidate

## USE THE CD & CHART TO:

- Teach Phonics
- Generate ideas for writing
- Teach complex vocabulary
- Introduce/consolidate nouns and adjectives
- Teach components of comprehension (e.g.: main idea, foreground and background of a picture, details, and artists' techniques that depict movement)
- Teach feelings
- Remediate or accelerate learning
- Work individually, small groups or whole class



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
